

Wyoming Medicaid reimburses the following eligible providers: Physicians; Advanced practice nurses with a specialty of psychiatry/mental health; **Eligible Providers** . Physician's assistant; Psychologists and neuropsychologists; Licensed Mental health professionals (LCSW, LPC, LMFT, LAT); Board Certified Behavioral Analysts; Speech therapist. Provisionally licensed mental health professionals cannot bill Medicaid directly, but must provide services through a supervising provider. Family Planning Clinics; • Public Health Offices; . Client's Home. A medical professional is not required to be present at the originating site, unless medically indicated. Each site is able to bill their own services as long as they are an enrolled Medicaid provider (includes out-of-state Medicaid providers).
